REQUIREMENTS:

Each teacher may enter up to ten students in the Riverside Young Pianists' Competition.

Applicant must be a student of a teacher who is an active member of the Riverside MTAC Branch.

Applicant must have studied with present teacher since the Fall Term, 2025.

Student applicant <u>may not</u> perform a piece that he or she has previously performed at a Riverside Young Pianists' Competition.

REPERTOIRE:

All students are required to play two pieces only from two different periods. Maximum time limits are as follows and will be strictly enforced:

Elementary I & II 5 minutes

Junior High 10 minutes

High School I and II 12 minutes

JUDGING:

Applicants must provide original copies of their music for the judges. Students presenting photocopies will be disqualified.

ALL MUSIC MUST BE PERFORMED BY MEMORY.

The decision of the judges is final. Judges reserve the right to not award a prize if they feel an acceptable level of performance is not reached.
